Subject:-Administrative approval and sanction of financial assistance for conducting Training Programme for the officials of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs Department of the State Government and members of Vigilance committees, etc, engaged in Public Distribution System for the year 2009-10 - Request from State Government of Assam

Sir,

I am directed to convey the administrative approval of the Central Government for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) by the Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of Assam, for conducting Training Programme for the officials of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs Department of the State Government and members of Vigilance committees etc, engaged in Public Distribution System for the year 2009-10. Government of India would provide financial assistance @ Rs. 500/- per person, per day. The cost has been restricted to Rs. 50,000/-.

2. I am further directed to convey the sanction of President of India for drawal and payment of Rs. 45,000/- (Rupees Forty Five Thousand only) being 90% of the total sanctioned amount to the Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of Assam, for conducting training programme for personnel associated with PDS as indicated above. Utilization certificate in the prescribed proforma (copy enclosed) and other documents mentioned in Para 3 of this letter may kindly be furnished immediately on utilization of the sanctioned amount. Necessary credit, may, therefore, be accorded to the State Government Account as per the procedure laid down in clause 8.18.1 of the Civil Accounts Manual under intimation to this Department.

3. The above sanction is subject to the following conditions:

(a) Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of Assam, will make their own arrangements for conducting the training course at the places decided by themselves. It is requested that the State Government should start the training programme urgently. The remaining amount will be sanctioned only after the successful completion of the training programme. The state government shall send a fresh proposal for the balance amount.

(b) The amount shall be spent for the purpose for which it is being sanctioned. Any part of the sanctioned amount which is not utilised shall be refunded to the Central Govt. immediately after the conclusion of the training programme along with the utilization certificates on the prescribed proforma.

(c) The financial assistance would be granted as per the expenditure asked for in their proposal.

(d) The State Government is directed that the training programme would be scheduled and conducted and the amount would be spent during the current financial year only. No request for re-validation of this sanction/amount will be entertained.

4. After completion of the training programme, a report of the Department, the list of topics covered by their faculty, the list of participants and the feedback received from the participants along with few copies of the material circulated to the participants shall be sent to this Department for releasing the second installment.

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Sir,

I am directed to convey the administrative approval of the Central Government for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty lakh only) by the Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of Gujarat, for conducting Training Programmes for personnel and members of Vigilance Committees engaged in Public Distribution System. The training programmes will be of 5 days and total number of participants will be 800. Government of India would provide financial assistance @ Rs. 500/- per person, per day. The maximum amount permissible under the scheme is Rs. 50,000/- per Training course. The cost has been restricted to Rs. 50,000/- per training programme.

I am further directed to convey the sanction of President of India for drawal and payment of Rs. 18,00,000/- (Rupees eighteen lakh only) being 90% of the total sanctioned amount to the Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of Gujarat, for conducting training programmes for personnel associated with PDS as indicated above. Utilization certificate in the prescribed proforma (copy enclosed) and other documents mentioned in Para 3 of this letter may kindly be furnished immediately on utilization of the sanctioned amount. Necessary credit, may, therefore, be accorded to the State Government Account as per the procedure laid down in clause 8.18.1 of the Civil Accounts Manual under intimation to this Department.
