ORDER


Subject:- Submission of Statutory Return Proforma-II in the modified format accompanied by copy of monthly Excise return ER-1 and RT 7(C) from the sugar season 2011-12 onwards - regarding.

Whereas, the current sugar season 2011-12 has started from 1st October, 2011 and all the sugar mills are required to furnish Proforma-II containing information/data regarding sugarcane crushed, white/ refined and raw sugar made from sugarcane, sugar recovery % cane, dispatches of levy and non-levy sugar, stocks of sugar and packing details of white/refined sugar etc. on periodic basis.

2. Whereas, it has been pointed out vide this Directorate's earlier Order dated 29.09.2011 that due to variations seen in the Proforma-II figures versus Central Excise No. RT 7(C) monthly return (sample test basis), it has been decided that henceforth the Proforma-II for the month end week submitted by the sugar mills should be accompanied by copy of monthly Excise Return, i.e. ER-1 & RT 7(C).

3. Whereas, it has been seen that some sugar mills has started producing raw sugar, besides white /refined sugar from sugarcane and dispatch such raw sugar to other sugar mills / refineries for further processing into white /refined sugar as well as are directly exporting raw sugar. Under this scenario, the levy entitlement remains intact and is to be fulfilled by the refiner of the raw sugar in one case and by the raw sugar exporter in the other case. This paradigm shift in the working of sugar sector as well as with the intention of obtaining all necessary information for the management of sugar sector in the country in one go, some modifications have been made in the Proforma-II after obtaining views of the industries representative bodies namely, Indian Sugar Mills Association (ISMA) and National Federation of Cooperative Sugar Factories Ltd.(NFCSF) as well as individual millers. The format of the Proforma-II, therefore, stands modified and is enclosed herewith and also posted on the **Ministry's Website: [www//http.fcamin.nic.in](http://www.fcamin.nic.in)**.

4. Whereas, in order to initiate steps for adoption of ICT sector technology to the extent possible, in the process, it has also been decided that the abstract of weekly Proforma-II returns for all the four weeks would be mandatorily sent through existing SMS-based module and the physical copies



of the Proforma II for the first, second and third week would not be insisted. However, the Proforma II return for the last week of the month should invariably be sent through hard copy along with month ending Excise returns ER-1 and RT 7(C).

5. Whereas it is also mandated that the month-ending proforma II returns, should not be submitted without signature of anybody below CEO/MD of the concerned factory.

6. Whereas, Directorate of Sugar is in the process of developing web based operating system and once it is operationalised, industry would be informed modalities of the use at the appropriate time.

7. Whereas, the Proforma-II as well as ICT based operating system (Mobile SMS/ web base returns) would be treated as Statutory Returns under the provisions in Clause 10 of the Sugar (Control) Order, 1966 which has been issued in exercise of the powers conferred by the Section 3(2)(h) of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and any violation is punishable under Section 7 of the said Act.

8. Whereas, if any manufacturer or producer of sugar furnishes false information as called for under Section 3 of the said Act, shall be punishable under Section 9 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

In view of the above, each sugar mill in the country is directed to furnish hard copy of prescribed statutory return Proforma-II accompanied by excise returns ER-1 & RT 7(C) for each month, complete in all respects and duly signed by the M.D. / Chief Executive of the sugar mill to this Directorate latest by 10th of next month apart from SMS based inputs at weekly intervals, i.e., on the 7th, 15th, 22nd and last day of the month.
